

# FRONT BUMPER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS 1999-2007, Ford F-Series Truck

#### Please read before beginning

- Stainless steel hardware may bind together when tightening—It is recommended that you apply an anti-seize assembly lubricant to the threads of each bolt before assembly
- This installation requires two people

#### Required tools

- Standard wrench set
- Leveling tool

### **Assembly instructions**

- 1. Remove Stock Bumper
- 2. Hold Aluminess bumper up in position and put the ½" bolt through the bumper and frame
- 3. Next, put one bolt on each side (each bolt should have a washer on both the head and the nut sides)
- 4. The hole on the bumper that is furthest away from the frame is the easiest one to start with
- 5. Hand tighten the nut down so the bumper can be rested on the bolt
- 6. Insert the other four bolts that go from inside the toolbox to the frame
- 7. Tighten the nuts down so that the bumper is held up but can still be moved
- 8. Check that the bumper is level and aligned with the center of the truck
- 9. Tighten down all of the fasteners, and check again after driving 100 miles to make sure everything is still secure
