

# <u>Dodge Promaster Roof Rack</u> <u>INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS</u>

#### Please read before beginning

- Stainless steel hardware may bind together when tightening—It is recommended that you apply an anti-seize assembly lubricant to the threads of each bolt before assembly
- This installation requires two people

Standard wrench set

#### Installation Instructions

- 1. Start by putting sliding the rubber mounting pad over each peg on the roof
- 2. Once the rubber mounting pads are in place, put 2 carriage bolts through the bottom of each stainless bracket and slide them over each peg on the roof.
- 3. Put the aluminum channel over the carriage bolts with the 2 legs of the channel sitting on the roof of the vehicle.
- 4. Set the roof rack down on the aluminum channel. You will have a slight bit of adjustment to get the rack to sit in the exact spot that you would like.
- 5. Tighten the 5/16" hardware to lock the roof rack to the roof of the vehicle.
  - a. Do not over tighten. This can be seen if the stainless steel bracket begins to warp into a "U" shape.
