



Windshield Cleaning:

Do not use a dry cloth, or your hands, to wipe off Windshield; Scratching will occur.

M8-1.25 x 20mm Lg. BHCS

- Do not use window cleaning fluids (Windex, 409, etc) or any solvents (gasoline, denatured alcohol, acetone, etc).
- Never use abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, or gritty cloths.
- 1. Thouroughly rinse Windshield to float off dirt and mud.
- 2. Using a soft cloth, or microfiber cloth, clean Windshield with warm water and a gentle detergent. Baby shampoo or hand washing soap are recommended.
- 3. To prevent water spots, use a chamois and blot Windshield dry.




Reference only; do not assemble completely at this time.

Install Seal to Windshield (A) as shown:

seal shown off for clarity only.

To ease installation, soak Seal in hot water before cutting or installing to increase flexibility.






Bulb Seal


Bulb portion of Seal to face towards vehicle

When assembling, do not tighten hardware completely.


- Install Top Frame (B) to Windshield (A) with hardware shown.
- Install Right and Left Female Hinges (M-L) with hardware shown.



- Install Lower Frame (H) to Windshield (A) with hardware shown.




- Insert Left Male Hinge (J) into Left Female Hinge (L). Provided Spacer must be installed.
- Secure Left Male Hinge (J) to hole located in stock Windshield Mount Plate with hardware shown.
- Repeat for Right side.




Hinge Alignment

To avoid binding when opening and closing Windshield, align Hinges before tightening hardware.



- Place Strut Clamp (E) and Left Strut Bracket (G) around Cab Frame as shown.
- Secure with hardware shown.
- Repeat for opposite side.






Gas Strut (C) Installation

- Install Gas Strut (C) to Left Strut Bracket (G).
- Repeat for Right Strut Bracket (F).



- Open Windshield (A) to just under 90° and secure Gas Strut (C) to Lower Frame with M8 Nylock Nut.
- Repeat for opposite side.

Extra hands are recommended for following steps:

- Close Windshield (A).
- Ensure that Windshield (A) is aligned to machine and Seal is in contact with Dash and Cage Frame as shown.



Catch (D) installation

- Remove (2) Plastic Rivets from Dash.
- Install Catch Mount (N) to Dash with hardware shown.
- Install each Catch (D) to Catch Mount (N) with hardware shown; do not tighten hardware.
- Close Windshield (A) and engage Latch.
- Ensure that Windshield (A) is aligned to machine and tighten all Catch (D) hardware completely.
