

BMS 2018+ KIA Stinger Solid Rear Differential Brace Install Guide for RWD only. Last updated 7/2/2019

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
Jack up the rear on either jack stands or a lift. Loosen and pull the 4 bottom bolts on the rear differential cover.




After removing the bolts, install the differential brace first onto the differential. Don't tighten anything down just yet until all diff brace pieces are on.



Slide the smaller bracket with the two welded nuts into the rear subframe slot as shown. The L shaped bracket will be tightened down to this using the two of the four bolts provided.





Attach the large bottom brace to the L shaped bracket using the last two provided bolts and lock nuts.



With the diff brace aligned and in place you can start tightening everything.



Installation is complete!
